RULES

1. **ENTRY**—Exhibits are limited to breeders of Lancaster County. **An entry fee of \$1.00 per animal must be paid before judging starts.** Exhibitors may enter in as many classes as they wish, but no exhibitor shall make more than two entries in a single class, for competition, nor can he win more than one premium in a single class, with one animal unless otherwise stated. All cattle exhibited must be exhibited in the name of the owner. Entries must be received by **September 1st**. 2. **TIME**—All animals for exhibition can be placed in the barn on Wednesday, but must be on the grounds and in their places by 4:00 P.M. Wednesday. Cattle will be released from the grounds at 9:00 P.M. Friday. Cattle removed prior to this time without permission will forfeit premium.
3. **CARE OF ANIMALS**—Exhibitors must themselves see to their delivery to the cattle superintendent so that the exhibits may be placed properly by 4:00 P.M. Wednesday. They are likewise required to attend to their animals while on exhibition.
4. **FEED & BEDDING**—Exhibitors must furnish all feed and bedding. **NO wood shavings or sawdust added to straw bed pack.**
5. **LIABILITY**—Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage done arising from any animal exhibited by him, if such loss or damage is due to negligence on his part. Any individual, spectator or patron handling animals without the consent of the owner is liable for all damage or injury done to themselves or animals.
6. **JUDGING**—The decision of the judges shall be final in all cases. **Where there are fewer entries in any class than the number of premiums offered, the judge may, at his discretion, award a prize of such grade as the animal deserves.** When there is no competition in a class the exhibitor shall receive ribbon merited, but only prize money for the next place below. Only entries that receive Blue Ribbons in their class are eligible to win Grand or Junior champion.
7. **PREMIUMS**—4-H and FFA members may receive premiums according to placing in both Open and Junior Division classes in the event that there are others in the Open Class beside 4-H and FFA members. If there are only 4-H and FFA members in the Open Class they shall receive Open Class premiums only. Department 11 will use same premiums list as Department 10.
8. **OWNERSHIP**—All animals must be owned by the exhibitor 60 days prior to this show and registration papers must be on hand for inspection at the time you bring animals in.
9. **4-H & FFA**—Any animal in the club groups may be shown in the open classes. 4-H & FFA exhibitor shall include any boy or girl who is an Active Member in 4-H or FFA in Lancaster County. The animal shown must be their club project. All entries to be judged as individuals in Department 10, Section 2.
10. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**—No entries under quarantine for any disease or showing clinical evidence of infectious or contagious disease will be admitted to the show. Please see health rules on page 19. **REMINDER - A current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is required for animals (Dairy Cattle) 3 months of age and older.** All vaccine label directions must be followed, and all rabies vaccinated cattle must be accompanied by a rabies vaccination certificate or the vaccination information must be included on the CVI. If a rabies vaccination certificate is provided, the certificate must contain legible name and contact information of the veterinarian who administered the vaccine and the veterinarian's signature. A copy of the rabies vaccination certificate is acceptable.


